


## Incoterms® 2010

Term	The seller must	The buyer bears all risk
EXW (EX Works) (at seller's premises or another named place, i.e. works, factory, warehouse)	place the goods at the disposal of the buyer at the seller's premises, not loaded on any collecting vehicle.	when the goods have been placed at the seller's premises.
FCA (Free CArrier) (named place, i.e. seller's premises)	deliver the goods to the named carrier at the seller's premises and <b>load</b> them <b>on the means of transport</b> provided by the carrier, cleared für export.	when the goods have been delivered to the carrier at the named place (loaded vehicle).
FCA (Free CArrier) (named place, i.e. any other place)	deliver the goods to the named carrier at any other place, cleared für export.  The seller is <b>not responsible for unloading</b> .	when the goods have been delivered unloaded at the carrier.
FAS (Free Alongside Ship) (named port of shipment)	place the goods alongside the vessel at the named port of shipment, cleared for export.	when the goods have been delivered alongside the vessel at the named <b>port of shipment</b> .
FOB (Free On Board) (named port of shipment)	deliver the goods on board the vessel at the named <b>port of shipment</b> and bear all risks of loss of or damage until that moment.	when the goods are on board the vessel nominated by him.
CFR (Cost and FReight) (named port of destination)	deliver the goods on board the vessel at the <b>port of shipment</b> .	when the goods are on board at the <b>port of shipment</b> and must receive the goods from the carrier at the named <b>port of destination</b> .
CIF (Cost, Insurance and FReight) (named port of destination)	- in addition to CFR – procure <b>marine insurance</b> (only with minimum cover including 10% anticipated profit) during the carriage.	when the goods are on board at the <b>port of shipment</b> and must receive the goods from the carrier at the named <b>port of destination</b> .
CPT (Carriage Paid To) (named place of destination)	deliver to the carrier nominated by him and pay the costs of carriage necessary to bring the goods to the named place of destination.	when the goods have been delivered to the carrier and must receive them from the carrier at the named place.
CIP (Carriage and Insurance Paid to) (named place of destination)	- in addition to CPT – procure <b>cargo insurance</b> (only with minimum cover including 10% anticipated profit) during the carriage.	when the goods have been delivered to the carrier and must receive them from the carrier at the named place.
DAP (Delivered At Place) (named place of destination)	bear costs and risks until the goods are placed at the disposal of the buyer on the arriving means of transport <b>ready for unloading</b> at the named <b>place</b> of destination.	when the goods - not cleared for import - have been placed, not unloaded from any arriving means of transport.
DAT (Delivered At Terminal) (named terminal at port or place of destination, i.e. a warehouse, container yard, quay, or road, rail or air cargo terminal)	place the goods – <b>unloaded</b> from the arriving means of transport - at the disposal of the buyer at a named terrminal at the named <b>port</b> or <b>place</b> of destination.	when the goods - not cleared for import - have been placed at the named <b>terminal</b> , <b>unloaded</b> from the arriving means of transport.
DDP (Delivered Duty Paid) (named place of destination)	bear costs and risks (including any duty for import) involved in bringing the goods at the named place in the country of destination.	when the goods - cleared for import - have been placed at the named place of destination, <b>not unloaded</b> from any arriving means of transport.
